## Information for International Fee-Paying Students

Havelock North High School has agreed to observe and be bound by the Education (**Pastoral Care of International Students**) Code of Practice 2016. Copies of the code are available on request from this institution or from the New Zealand Ministry of Education website at <http://www.minedu.govt.nz>.

### Fees

(a) **Tuition Fees**

They cover all tuition costs related to the school curriculum. Tuition fees do not cover examination fees. These are the student's responsibility. German students do not usually sit examinations.

(b) **Administration Fee**

The administration fee is non-refundable. From 2023 the administration fee will be \$800.00

(c) **Accommodation Arrangements**

All students that wish to attend Havelock North High School must stay in a school-approved homestay or with a family designated by their parents. High quality homestays are organised by the school. Homestay transfer fee is \$400.00

Homestay fees may increase \$40 per week in the case of students with special dietary requirements such as, and not limited to, lactose intolerance, gluten free, vegetarian or vegan etc.

(d) **Other fees.**

The school offers many sports and cultural activities. The price of these varies. Uniform is compulsory and can be purchased new for approximately \$400. Most of this can be recouped on departure by selling through the school shop, Threads.

NCEA examination fees \$383.00

Visa application \$410.00

Te Kura Correspondence School extra subjects \$1700.00

Insurance \$620.00 per annum in 2024.

(e) **Sports, Cultural Activities and Outdoor Education.**

International students pay for sport and cultural activities in the same way NZ students do. There is a three week outdoor education programme included in the tuition fee. i.e. 3 weeks of outdoor ed. free in November for students not doing NCEA examinations. This excludes rafting, parachuting and bungy jumping and other high cost activities which students must pay for.

### Refund.

A refund is available to a student's family on application to the school in writing, from the next term for tuition fees and from the time the student leaves the school's care for homestay. Administration fees, NCEA fees, insurance and other fees paid on behalf of the student are not refundable.
